Banding 2016

The Delta Marsh Bird Observatory set up at Oak Hammock Marsh Interpretive Centre again this year, expanding their on-going program.

Highlights included:

- Hiring Jeff Costa to be the BIC.
- Banding daily from July 18th to October 8th, which was 70 days of banding.
- Supplementing with a great number of volunteers.
- Volunteers response was phenomenal.
- Running no more than 6 nets most often only 4 nets.
- Trying to do a daily census but only succeeding if there were volunteers.
- Birds banded: 2494 (includes retraps)
- Total species: 64
- Total mist net hours: 1816
- Birds per mist net hour: 1.37
- Visitors: 520Volunteers: 30
- Volunteer hours: 886
- Species caught for the first time:
 - Alder & Willow Flycatchers
 - Cliff Swallow
 - Common Nighthawk
 - Red-breasted Nuthatch
 - Northern Saw-whet Owl
 - Sedge Wren
- Facebook views: 8824
- Hosted a CWS banding workshop in September.
- Tried Saw-whet owl banding for four nights and caught 5 birds.
- We did 6 media interviews
- We gave the Minister of Sustainable Development a demonstration.
